COVID-19 Positive Test

Bottomline:

If after a Weekend Service we get notified of a probable or confirmed COVID-19 case from an attendee, DreamTeam or Staff Member we will initiate the following steps.

Ask the individual the following questions:

What are your symptoms?

- Cough, fever, or shortness of breath?

Have you been tested for COVID-19?

- If yes, when do you expect to have results?

Were you within 6 feet of anyone else for at least 15 minutes?

- If yes, can you provide a list of those close contacts?
- If yes, were you and all other close contacts wearing a mask?

Could you please notify us if you receive COVID-19 test results?

Give the individual our recommendations:

- Per Ohio Department of Health guidelines, our recommendation would be to self-isolate for 14 days or until you have a confirmed negative test result.
- We ask that you do not come back to a CedarCreek facility until you are symptom free for 14 days.
- Once you are ready to return, could you please contact us and let us know?

Next Steps:

- If not in the loop, notify the Campus Pastor
 - Campus Pastor notify the Executive Director of Campuses
- If applicable, provide a list the close contacts
- If applicable, work with the Executive Director of Campuses and HR to put together a communication strategy for reaching out to the list of close contacts

Proactive Communication

We recommend the following:

- Stay home when you are feeling sick.
- Wear a face covering when going out.
- Practice social distancing of at least 6 feet from others
- Wash hands often with water and soap (20 seconds or longer)
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth with unwashed hands or after touching surfaces
- Cover your mouth with a tissue or sleeve when coughing or sneezing
