Campus Animal Policy

Anytime a dog is on our property, initiate a conversation and walk through the following actions steps to ensure the safety of our guests at all of our locations. Our highest priority is the safety of our guests.

Information to share:

- 1. Inform the handler that the dog must be harnessed, leashed or tethered at all times.
- 2. Inform the handler of the designated areas in the building, which include the auditorium, atriums, and classrooms.
- 3. Anytime a situation becomes disruptive, dangerous or a threat to the safety of the campus or those in attendance, the Campus Pastor (or the staff member acting in place of the Campus Pastor at the time) and or safety team will ask the handler and dog to leave the premises including the parking lot.

Questions to ask if needed:

- 1. Ask what service the dog is providing?
- 2. Ask for proof of liability insurance.
- 3. Ask for a canine health exam along with current vaccination record by a certified veterinarian.
