CELEBRATE RECOVERY STAFF GUIDELINES

Vision:

- Groups exist for all guests to connect and engage regularly with others to grow towards full investment and commitment to love Jesus, serve others and tell the world about Christ.
- Alongside serving is the foundational strategy to the next step of connect for growth.

Wins:

- To have a working knowledge of Celebrate Recovery programming and structure
- To provide on-going support and encouragement to the volunteers and celebrate the ministry accomplishments
- To be an advocate at the campus for the ministry work of Celebrate Recovery

CENTRAL SUPPORT PROVIDES:

- Senior director of adult ministries serves as liaison and advisor to director of Celebrate Recovery
- Senior director of adult ministries holds regular meetings and communication with director
- Senior director of adult ministries provides alignment on overall strategy, promotion and branding for ministry as relates to church initiatives
- Senior director of adult ministries serves as advocate for ministry
- Senior director of adult ministries coordinates alignment with senior director of children's ministry and senior director of student ministries on Celebration Place and The Landing that includes regular meetings
- Senior director of adult ministries provides regular updates to campuses about Celebrate Recovery including attendance trends, ministry wins, etc.
- Senior director of adult ministries communicates and collaborates directly with campus pastor on any campus specific issues

CAMPUS STAFF PROVIDES:

- Campus pastors visit Friday night once a quarter
- Campus pastors check-in with ministry leader regularly for updates and to provide campus-specific support
- Campus pastor supports and assists any issues or problems with impact across
 CR campus team as needed
- Campus pastor provides input, recommendations and approval of volunteer leaders
- Campus pastor collaborates with director of adult ministries on issues or problems affecting their campus CR

• KidKare staff members execute Celebration Place programming as provided by Celebrate Recovery central support

CAMPUS BEST PRACTICES:

- Offer to host a meal for the campus team
- Serve as "cook" on Friday night when a meal is already being served to the ministry
- Attend with a guest you have recommended Celebrate Recovery to and sit with them during large program
- After attending on a Friday night, complete the standards checklist on CreekHelp to let them know how specifically they are winning
- Ask the leaders after chip night who they are celebrating
