IOUR VISION

IOUR TEAMS

Greeters

Our Greeter DreamTeam members use their gifts to encourage, open doors, welcome, and provide weekend service notes for each guest.

Ushers

Our Usher DreamTeam uses their gifts to assist guests with finding a seat and strives to provide our guests with a positive, distraction-free, comfortable atmosphere, allowing them to worship and hear the message.

Brew Crew

The Brew Crew DreamTeam members use their gifts to prepare coffee, soda, and other beverages. Team members also assist in keeping a clean environment for our guests.

Sparkle Crew

The Sparkle DreamTeam members use their gifts to make sure that the facility provides a clean and presentable atmosphere. Everything communicates something, and a clean environment communicates that we care about our guests.

Parking Team

Parking DreamTeam members are the first connections guests have with our church when they arrive. This DreamTeam welcomes guests with a smile and wave as they arrive and depart from the parking lots. This team will also guide guests as they enter and exit the parking lot, ensuring safety and efficiency.

Guest Services

Guest Services DreamTeam members use their gifts to serve guests at the one stop that provides connection first and then information and resources that will help them take a next step in their relationship with Christ.

Lobby Hosts

The Lobby Host Team exemplifies CedarCreek's value that every person matters through engaging with people in the common areas and the auditorium.

Your Serve: It all starts with the huddle.

A huddle for a sports team is the action of a team gathering together, usually in a tight circle, to strategize, motivate, or celebrate. Commonly the leader will try to inspire his fellow team members to achieve success. Similarly, our DreamTeam has action and wins to accomplish each week. First Impressions DreamTeam members should arrive early to attend their DreamTeam huddle. Being on time and at the huddle helps your Team Lead plan and prepare to serve our guests well.

The huddle will also equip you as a DreamTeam member to be on mission with others in purpose and vision for the weekend services.

Best Practices

To create a welcoming environment, here are some points to remember.

- Attend the DreamTeam huddle. Being on time is one of the ways we serve with excellence.
- Check in each time you serve. This helps us know the health of our teams and care for you as a DreamTeam member.
- Know the location of all kids and students areas, restrooms, and NextSteps areas such as GrowthTrack and Guest Services.
- Be aware of any special events that weekend.

- Your children may come to the DreamTeam huddle until their rooms are ready. We ask that they not "assist" you while you are serving.
- Be in position at least 15 minutes before the service begins.
- Keep hands free so guests know that you are ready to serve.
- Please refrain from texting or using your phone while you are serving.
- Please limit personal conversations with friends and other DreamTeam members until after your serve.

Dress Code

What we wear can sometimes speak louder than what we say. The attire is casual for weekend services, but use discretion. If you think your attire is questionable then simply do not wear it. We also have a lanyard with a name badge for you to wear when you serve so that the team and guests can know who you are.

How You Will be Scheduled

Planning Center is an online system we use to schedule team members and communicate throughout the week. You will be given the opportunity to set up a username and password to login; however, most team members find that receiving and responding to the scheduling request emails, as well as reviewing the updates sent to their email, is most effective.

In addition, we will also have periodic team meetings and gatherings that will be scheduled and communicated through Planning Center as well.

Communication is crucial for building community and carrying out effective ministry, so please let your Team Leader know your availability to serve or when you aren't able to serve for a scheduled time.

- Oversee day-of ministry area vision, mission, team preparation, logistics flow, changeover in teams; ensuring staffing; provide vision at each huddle
- Communicate weekly with Team Leaders
- Care for Team Leaders
- Develop the DreamTeam culture of being on mission together as we make a difference

First Impressions Team Leader

Oversee the service - 5:15, 9, 10:45, 12:30

- Pray for team members daily
- Oversee the service for their ministry area – specific weekend logistics and details
- Work with DreamTeam Coach on equipping team members and identifying areas where training is needed
- Maintain DreamTeam culture of being on mission together as we make a difference

- Identify and work through issues and problems
- Protect DreamTeam culture
- Communicate weekly with team members – each accept or decline is an opportunity to reach out
- Care for team members
- Help every DreamTeam member feel known and needed
- Celebrate team wins and share those wins
 with their First Impressions Coach

DreamTeam Co-Leader

Assist the service - 5:15, 9, 10:45, 12:30

- Praying for Team Members daily
- Oversee at their service check-in for their ministry area and assist with specific weekend logistics and details
- Work with DreamTeam Team Leader on identifying areas for training and equipping
- Assist with issues and problems
- Help every team member feel known and needed
- Coordinate communication on birthdays, anniversaries, and other special days to remember of team members
- Assist in care and celebration of team wins
