#### PRE-EVENT

- Coordinate communication with Group Leaders.

- Spiritually lead Group Leaders.
- Create a fun, safe, "kid focused" atmosphere for Group Leaders.
- Provide support to Group Leaders.
- Create and maintain Groups unity.
- Take an active role in greeting families at check-in.
- Assist the Groups Coordinator in keeping Group Leaders on schedule.
- Be available to resolve questions and challenges with Group Leaders.

**POST-EVENT**

- Take an active role in greeting families at checkout.
- Help return all group supplies to their proper locations; whether at the campus or central support.
