SCHEDULE

- The LivingItOut is produced weekly, beginning Wednesdays for writers and concluding Saturdays for proofers.
- Team Members have the opportunity to write each month. Sign ups are completed through Planning Center.
- Writing happens from Wednesday 6pm-Friday 9am each week. Submissions are shared via a Google Doc.

TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Chose a serve opportunity.** Be familiar with Planning Center, and sign up at least once per month.
- Attend the weekend service.
- Be familiar with and living out the four principles of the life-changing adventure, or spiritual journey, to Know God, Find Freedom, Discover Purpose and Make a Difference. These four principles are central to how people spiritually grow and are how we communicate what we see God doing in peoples' lives throughout Scripture and today.
- **Prepare in prayer.** Pray for God's heart for people each and every time you serve. Ask God how you can put someone else at ease and for the Lord to use you today.

• Writer's focus:

- Be thoroughly familiar with the proper formatting rules found in the LIO Style Guide.
- Select preferred day to write from the email that arrives Wednesdays at 6pm of the week you are writing.
- View pre-record video of the message to help you prepare. The link is included within the Wednesday email.
- Compose a <u>400 word</u> devotion based on the theme of the day you selected. Be mindful of length to keep our readers engaged. Please realize longer submissions will be edited as need.
- Craft content that relates to CedarCreek's mission and vision.
- Integrate steps of the spiritual journey and the week's bottom line as appropriate.
- Include questions, next steps, and a prayer as requested in weekly outline.
- Incorporate scripture from the message as appropriate. Additional supporting scripture may also be included.
- Aim for good flow and consistent tone throughout your devotion.
- Check for proper spelling, grammar and punctuation.
- Add your submission to the Google doc by 9am Friday. Link is found in sign up email.
- Add a catchy title to your submission.
