Vision

Our heart is to create a welcoming, distraction free experience during each weekend service for our guests to know God more and take a step in their life-changing adventure with him. The ultimate goal is to invite our guests to focus on God alone.

1. Be modest: While looking in a mirror, raise your arms as high as possible and swing them in all directions to ensure you are not inappropriately revealing skin. (Women: if wearing short sleeves, lift arms to make sure you cannot see inside your shirt through the sleeve opening.)

2. Be conscientious: For lighting and camera purposes, please do not wear neon, white, or skin tone-colors, busy patterns, or sunglasses/transition lenses. Please make sure any hats do not cast shadows on your eyes.

3. Be guest-focused: Avoid distracting logos, patterns and colors. Ask yourself: "Could anything about my outfit distract a guest from worship?"

SPECIFIC DO'S AND DON'TS

SHIRTS

No slogans, statements, logos or graphic T's

- This eliminates guests having to spend time deciphering what is, or is not, on someone's shirt
- CedarCreek logo items are ok

Avoid distracting patterns or colors

Layers are encouraged – jackets, cardigans, hoodies, etc.

PANTS

Pants or jeans only – no skirts, dresses, or shorts

No leggings, yoga pants, sweat pants or joggers

Distressed denim is acceptable as long as there are no excessive holes

- Ask yourself: "Is there skin showing above my knees?"

ACCESSORIES

Closed-toed shoes only

Make sure hats do not cover your eyes

- Ask yourself: "Can I look up without moving my head and see the lights above me?"

No sunglasses or transition lenses
