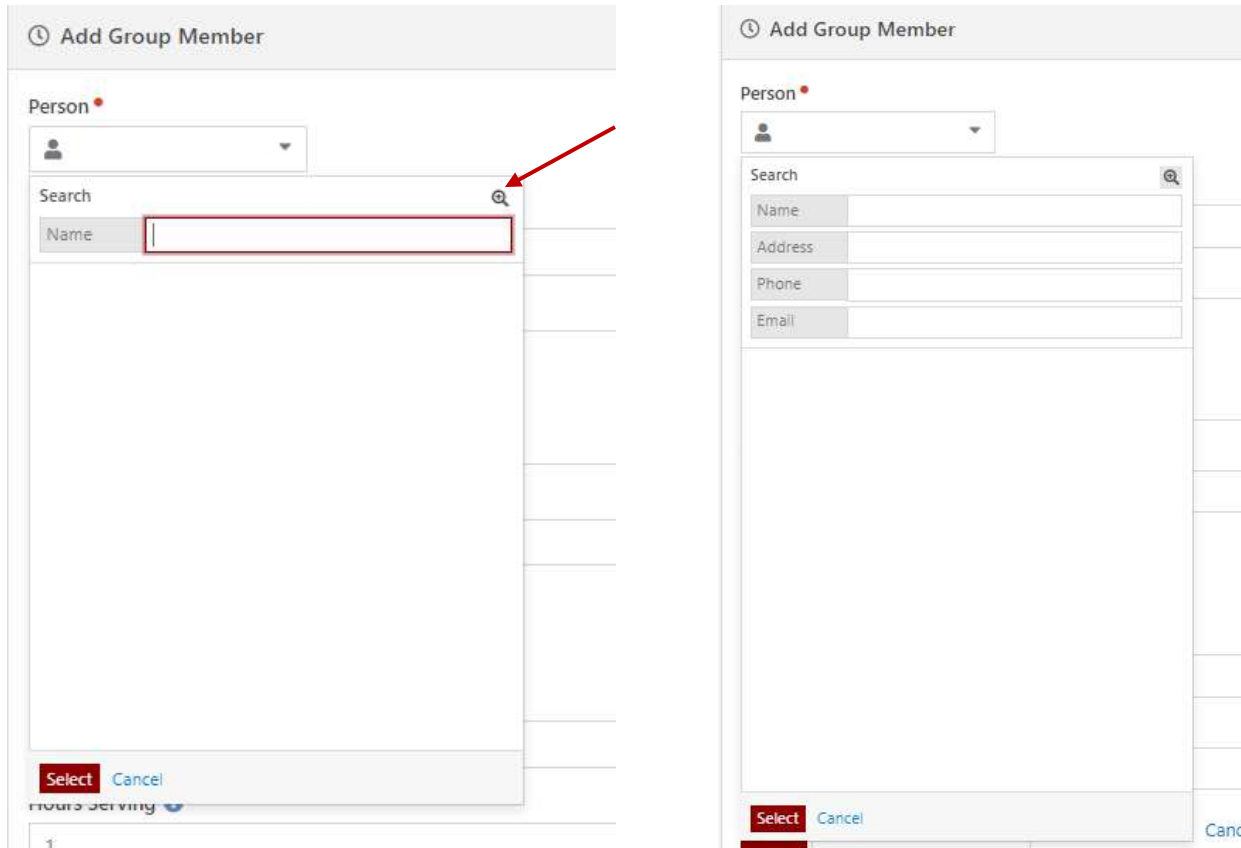


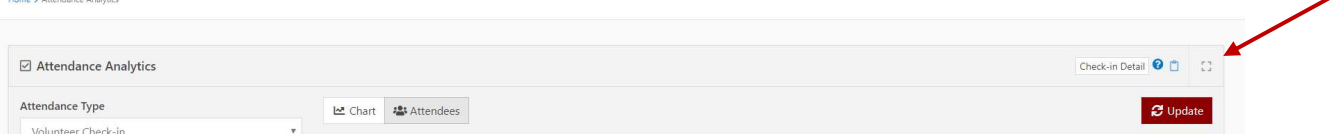
Feature changes

1. **GENERAL** - Added ability to search by address, phone, and email.
 - a. When you add a new group member or try to search for someone in attendance check-in details, you will be able to search for people by name, phone, email or address!
 - b. Click the magnifying glass in the upper right corner to get further options
 - c. Fill-in the ONE field that you have for the person.



2. **GENERAL** - SMS Conversations – this only affects a few people. If you are one of them you will receive more information from Jason Jones.
3. **GENERAL** - Export updates!
 - a. When exporting grids, date fields will now be date fields in Excel as well!
 - b. You will now be able to highlight cells without converting the file in any way.
4. **GENERAL** - You'll notice a new button on Attendance Analytics. This will allow you to go full screen for these pages.

5. **GENERAL** - When someone is marked as inactive because they are deceased the system will ask for a deceased date.
6. **CONNECTIONS** - On the connections page, if you are pulling up the list of all connections the last activity column will now sort by timeframe instead of by name of activity.
7. **FINANCE** - You can now filter batches by source type.
8. **FINANCE** - Updates to Check Scanning - New version to be installed on November 20th or November 27th.
9. **GROUPS** - Group leaders will now have the ability to update/edit their group's capacity.
10. **GROUPS** - If someone registers for more than 1 group, all group leaders will be notified.
11. **GROUPS** - Leaders will now be informed when members have been absent for consecutive number of meetings.
12. **GROUPS** - Group members will be made **INACTIVE** when the group is made **INACTIVE**. If a group is made **ACTIVE** again, all members that were **ACTIVE** when the group was made **INACTIVE** will be **ACTIVE** again, those that were already inactive, will remain **INACTIVE**.
13. **REGISTRATIONS** - You can now sort an event registration by "registered by". This makes it much easier to search if you are looking for someone specific or looking for duplicate registrations.
