

Salvation and Baptism

We love helping kids and families take next steps! If a child is asking questions about salvation and is wanting to make Jesus their Forever Friend, it's important to bring parents into the conversation. Our role is to partner with parents; honoring the parent's role as their child's spiritual leader. Our Kids Next Steps Book is a great resource to help equip parents.

We use the following language when having salvation conversations with kids:

- A. Admit
- B. Believe
- C. Commit

If a child has asked Jesus to be their Forever Friend, we encourage the next step of baptism. We recommend the child has thoughtful answers to the following questions before being baptized.

1. Have you asked Jesus to be your Forever Friend? Tell me about that.
2. Why do people get baptized?
3. Why do you want to be baptized?

If a child's next step is baptism, a Kids Staff Member will help walk the family through the process.
