## **TEAM'S GUIDING SCRIPTURE**

*I urge you, first of all, to pray for all people. Ask God to help them; intercede on their behalf, and give thanks for them.* "I Timothy 2:1 (NLT)

#### **TEAM VISION**

To compassionately intercede for the needs of our guests, helping them to experience the love of Jesus so that they can connect with Christ through prayer, and to supportively intercede for the ministries, staff, and leadership of our church.

### HOW DO WE DO THIS

We let the G.U.E.S.T. principles guide every opportunity and interaction:

- God's Heart we want every guest to know they matter to God and to us.
- Upbeat we are fun, positive people who make an amazing first impression.
- Excellence our attention to detail shows our guest we care.
- Seize Wow Opportunities *make their experience something they can't wait to share with others.*
- Take a Next Step we are always looking for opportunities to help guests take a next step.

#### SCHEDULE

- Alternate Saturdays, 5:00/Sundays 9:00 or 11:00.
- Arrive 30 minutes prior to service for huddle, to check in and get your lanyard.
- Auditorium doors open 15 minutes before the service begins.
- Be seated near the area the intercessors serve from.

#### **OUR TEAM ROLE**

There are two different roles during our weekend service for prayer.

Intercession during the service for the weekend service (coming soon):

- Praying during each weekend service for entirety of service in designated quiet area
- Praying over specific part of the service as it is happening

Intercession on behalf of the person who is requesting prayer:

- Intercession is praying on behalf of the person the request is for and lifting their need to God. As an intercessor, you are often the first one to hear how the Holy Spirit has impacted the heart of our guest through our service/message.
- We have an opportunity to serve our guest in a powerful way, helping them connect to the heart of Christ which can give them hope, comfort and peace.
- As a part of this team, we begin our serving experience at home, preparing our own heart, praying for the impact of the service, and for those God is going to send to us for prayer.
- Serve while authentically representing Jesus. You have been entrusted by our church to serve our guests through prayer, interceding for them, their family members, friends and co-workers who may not yet know Jesus.
- Cheerfully and compassionately we greet our guests. Using their name, pray for them and for their requests, all in order to show the love of Jesus to each individual that comes for prayer.

• Following prayer, we offer words of encouragement, hope, and next step suggestions, so that they will feel they matter to God, to us, and will desire to get connected in our church body.

Both weekend roles may also have the option of taking part in our Weekly Prayer Team to continue to pray for our guests during the week as well as the other guest requests, our staff, leadership, and ministries of CedarCreek Church.

# **TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Pray daily.
- Arrive on time for scheduled serve.
- Evaluate role as intercessor and look for ways to improve, especially from your team perspective.
- Respond to Planning Center invites and communicate regularly with ministry leaders on experience and availability.

# **TEAM RESULTS**

Through attentiveness, prayer and encouragement, guests are shown how much they matter to God and that He cares about the people they are asking prayer for, that their prayer request is important to us, and that prayer is a central part of our church.
