PRAYER TEAM'S GUIDING SCRIPTURE

I urge you first of all, to pray for all people. Ask God to help them; intercede on their behalf, and give thanks for them."1 Timothy 2:1 (NLT)

TEAM VISION

To compassionately intercede for the needs of our guests, helping them to experience the love of Jesus so that they can connect with Christ through prayer, and to supportively intercede for the ministries, staff, and leadership of our church.

HOW DO WE DO THIS

We let the G.U.E.S.T. principles guide every opportunity and interaction:

- God's Heart – *we want every guest to know they matter to God and to us.*
- Upbeat – *we are fun, positive people who make an amazing first impression.*
- Excellence – *our attention to detail shows our guest we care.*
- Seize Wow Opportunities – *make their experience something they can't wait to share with others.*
- Take a Next Step – *we are always looking for opportunities to help guests take a next step.*

SCHEDULE

- Prayer requests come from several sources; the prayer boxes at all campuses, from the people that seek prayer down front after services, phone calls to the office, from staff, and through our website.
- These requests are compiled into Rock to be prayed for by our team
- Pray 2-3 times a week

OUR TEAM ROLE

- Intercession is praying on behalf of the person the request is for and lifting their need to God. As an Intercessor, we hear both the heartache of our guest and how the Holy Spirit has been impacting the heart of our guest.
- We have an opportunity to serve our guest in a powerful way, helping them connect to the heart of Christ which can give them hope, comfort and peace.
- As a part of this team, we begin our serving experience at home by preparing our own heart first, asking God to help us pray according to His will as we intercede for our guests.
- Serve while authentically representing Jesus. You have been entrusted by our church to serve our guests through prayer, interceding for them, their family members, friends and co-workers who may not yet know Jesus.

TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES

- Pray daily
- Complete prayer requests through Rock at least 3 times a week (requests in each category following the weekend services on Sunday, Monday, and Tuesdays are usually longer than those going out later in the week)
- Respond to those that have requested encouragement

TEAM RESULTS

Through the prayers of our team, guests experience hope and that freedom through Jesus is possible; how much they matter to God and that He cares about the people they are asking prayer for; that their prayer request is important to us and guests who want encouragement, receive it; and that we support our church body and leadership through prayer which is a central part of our church.
